

Directions to the Old Medical School at Leeds General Infirmary

Leeds General Infirmary (LGI) is located in Leeds city centre. The easiest way to get to LGI is on the train; the hospital is then approximately 15-20 minutes walk from Leeds railway station. The best way to find the directions is by entering the LGI postcode, LS1 3EX, into a website such as [Google Maps](#). There is a bus service which circles the city centre and stops at the LGI. However, this bus probably takes the same amount of time as it does to walk to LGI from the station.

If you're flying to Leeds then you will need to take a bus/taxi from the airport to the city centre. The 747 bus brings you to the city centre. Details can be found at

The cost of the bus is upwards of £2, I'm unsure as to the time this takes to get to the city centre.


Taxis you have to **book one at the taxi booking cabin near the bus stops and drop off area.**

The main bus route through the city centre is a road called The Headrow. Any bus which stops on the Headrow will get you close to LGI, especially if you alight as close to the Town Hall as possible. Bus information can be found at:

Parking at LGI is **very very** limited and will cost £15 for 8 hours. There are many other car parks in the city centre the best of which is the Woodhouse lane park which is 10 minutes' walk from the LGI, and has a charge of around £5:00 for the day.

The Old Medical School (8) is located at the far end of Great George Street near to St Georges Church.
